

Your ticket to big savings

Network Warrington operates a comprehensive network of bus services to all parts of town, and further afield to Altrincham, Earlestown, Leigh, Newton-le-Willows and Northwich. We always strive to deliver the best possible service to our customers, and offer a wide range of tickets that can help you make big savings, wherever you want to go on our buses.

Singles

Standard single tickets can be purchased from the driver at any time for any journey on one bus, with child singles also available at a reduced rate.

Prices: Adult prices start at 80p and rise to £2.85 for longer journeys.

Day Returns

Money saving Day Returns are available from the driver for most journeys and are valid for one return journey on the day of issue. Adult tickets can be bought anytime, but child tickets can only be purchased after 0900 on Monday to Friday, but anytime on Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays.

Prices: Adult prices range from £1.55 to £3.20.

£5 Family Day Return

Great value for 2, 3 or 4 people travelling together when at least one person is under sixteen, these tickets can be bought on the bus and are valid for one return journey anytime on the day of issue, except before 0900 on schooldays.



Hospital Thrufare

These tickets make journeys to or from Warrington Hospital on Lovely Lane so much easier, and cheaper too.

To the Hospital:

- Buy a Thrufare ticket from the driver of your bus into town
- Change at either Warrington Interchange or Legh Street
- Show Thrufare ticket to driver of bus from town to Hospital

From the Hospital:

- Buy a Thrufare ticket from the driver of your bus into town
- Change at either Warrington Interchange, Legh Street or Sankey Street
- Show Thrufare ticket to driver of bus from town to your destination

Prices: A 80p supplement is added to the price of your normal single ticket.

There are no child rate or return Thrufares.

Town Centre Fare

If you're on a bus passing the Town Hall or Central Station and want to get to Bridge Street or Academy Way, you can change buses at Warrington Interchange or Sankey Street without any extra charge – just show your ticket to the driver. You can also make this journey, or one from Academy Way and Scotland Road back to Warrington Interchange, for a special 10p single fare.

Day Rovers

Day Rovers can be bought on the bus and offer great value unlimited travel for one day at anytime, with special tickets available that cater for everyone.

Prices: Adult £3.50, +1 child £4.00, +2 children £4.50

Senior citizen/disabled person £1.75, +1 child £2.25, +2 children £2.75

Child £2.20, only available to holders of Network Warrington Under 16 Permits after 0900 Monday to Friday, but anytime on Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays.

Savercards

There are two types of Savercard, and both offer cheap, unlimited travel at all times in weekly and monthly formats. Town Savers cover most parts of town and Network Savers give complete coverage of all our services – just present a passport sized photograph to the Network Warrington Information Office at Warrington Interchange to receive your membership card and wallet.

Prices: Town Weekly £12.00, Town Monthly £39.00
Network Weekly £15.50, Network Monthly £51.00
Network Annual £430.00

20.21 Rider

Regular travellers on services 20 and 21 can save money with a 20.21Rider. They give unlimited travel on services 20, 20A, 21 and 21A on the day of issue and for the following six days. Buy them on the bus, it couldn't be easier.

Price: £9.25

Young Travellers

We also offer a wide range of money saving deals for families and children:

- Up to two children under 5 travel free accompanied by an adult (aged 16 or over)
- Children aged 5 to 15 inclusive travel at reduced rates, usually around half the adult fare
- 70p child fare for journeys within Greater Manchester

Under 16s who look 16 or older can obtain a Network Warrington Under 16 Permit for 50p (call to request an application form).



Over 60, reduced mobility or visually impaired

With a senior citizen/disabled National Concessionary Travel Pass, you can travel by bus for free in Warrington, Halton and Cheshire after 0930 on Monday to Friday, and all day Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays. The pass is also valid for free travel throughout England. Just contact your local council to obtain your money saving travel pass and for details of availability in other parts of the country, using the relevant number below.
